













"The 1989 Mt. Lebanon soccer team will undoubtedly be remembered as the most skilled team in Lebo soccer history. Led by senior co-captains Vee Hightower, Bill Friday, and Mike Hammer, this year's team dominated like no other soccer team, with the possible exception of the 1981 state championship team. We finished our season with a 14-0 record. Lebo's toughest section game came in the final regular season game of the year against rivals Upper St. Clair. USC took a 2-0 lead into the locker room, and for the first time in the season an opponent had held a lead against Lebo. We came out fired up in the second half. Bill Friday scored just two minutes into the half and Doug Hammel tied it up in the fourth quarter with a head ball goal. The game went into overtime until Geoff Tomb broke the deadlock with a goal and Lebo came out with a big emotional victory. The team met Norwin in the WPIAL finals, and in a physical game Norwin held us scoreless for three quarters with their incredible goaltending. It also made John and Ron Wilcher the first father and son coaching duo to win WPIALS ever. We were ranked #1 and met #2 ranked Downingtown in the state championship. We failed to convert on numerous scoring opportunities in the first half, and at the half the score was 0-0. Then in the fourth quarter, Downingtown scored what proved to be the game-winner. It was a difficult loss to take. However, the team finished first in the section and second in the state. The team carried a 25-1 record and its explosive offense set a record for goals with 121. Vegrin Hightower was selected WPIAL Player of the Year and an All State Selection and was named All American by the National Soccer Coaches Athletics Association. He led the way with 40 goals and 20 assists. The team wishes to thank the coaching staff, and although it didn't achieve the ultimate goal, it had unparalleled success, and, most of all, the team had great times."


















